

### Abstract

I had written a paper in 1989 entitled “Karl Popper on Christianity”. It was renamed “Karl Popper’s Views on Religion: Judaism, Christianity, and Critical Rationalism” and published in 2001 in the collection of papers entitled *Critical Rationalism*, vol. 1, edited by the Japan Popper Society. At that time I was unaware of any publications by Popper whose main theme was religion, and I had based my position on sporadic remarks made by Popper in his various writings. However, in light of the 2008 publication of a collection of papers by Popper (*After the Open Society: Selected Social and Political Writings*, eds. Jeremy Shearmur and Piers Norris Turner), which includes Popper's papers on religion (e.g., “Science and Religion”), I present a reappraisal of Popper’s views on religion.
